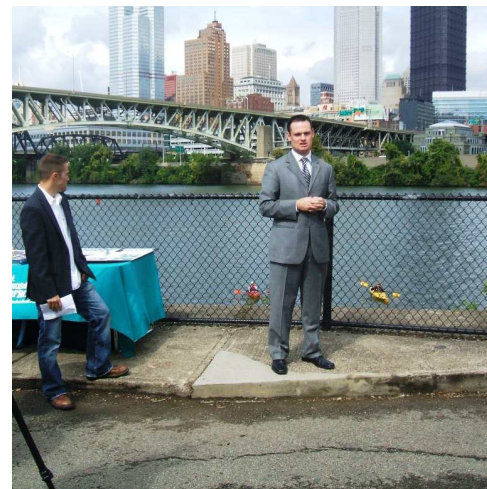
2009/2010 MEMBERSHIP PROJECTS

VERONA BOATHOUSE GROUNDBREAKING

Verona is soon to be home to a new green rowing facility. The groundbreaking took place on Friday, October 10th next to the public docks in Verona at the end of a walking trail that will lead to the Highland Park Bridge. The \$2.2 million facility will be built on ground where a lumber warehouse once stood. A community room, public restrooms, indoor rowing and expertise facilities, storage space for kayaks and boats as well as parking will all be attributes of the building. The expected date of completion is in 2009 sometime.
