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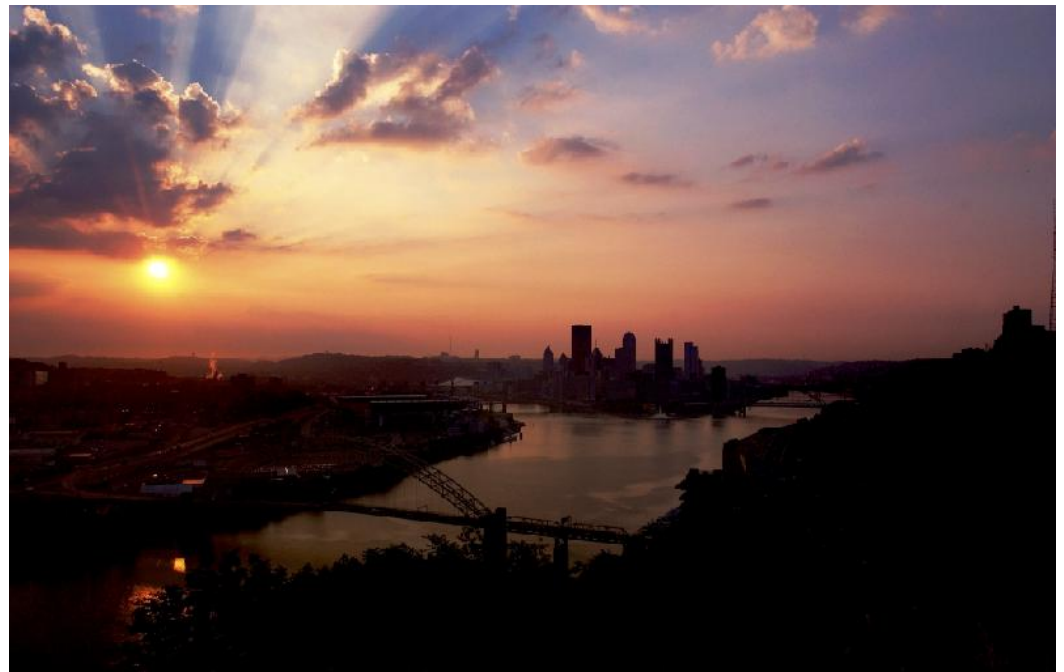
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## FRIENDS OF THE RIVERFRONT

## TRAIL CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Work on the Route 28 Trail segment between the City of Pittsburgh and Borough of Millvale is moving along swiftly. Brayman Construction Corporation has been selected to undertake the project and have recently finished surveying and clearing the area for the new trail. In order to avoid interrupting trail connectivity, a temporary trail is currently being built and will be in place by January 29th.
