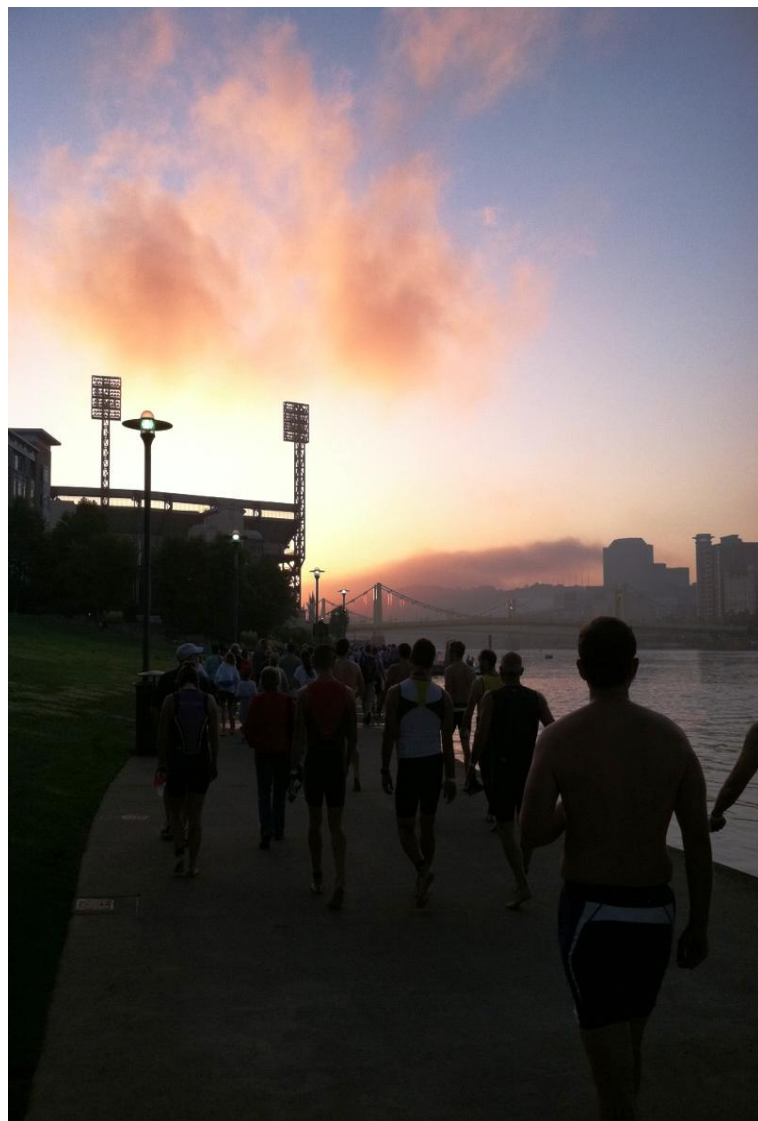

GREAT ALLEGHENY PASSAGE ECONOMIC IMPACT STUDY

The Trail Town Program in partnership with Allegheny Trail Alliance, and Laurel Highlands Visitors Bureau presented the latest statistics on the economic impact of the Great Allegheny Passage.

Volunteers completed nearly 1200 surveys of trail users between Homestead, PA and Cumberland, MD, and the findings have been recorded in this new report.
