

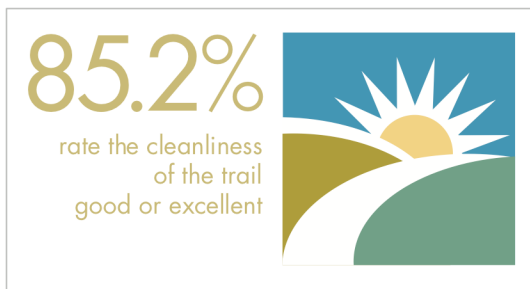
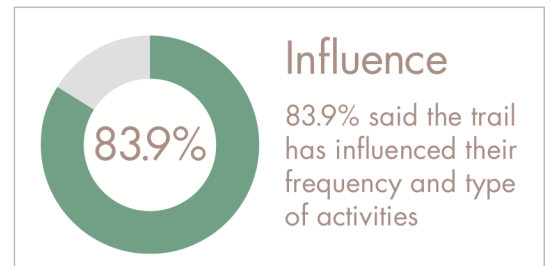
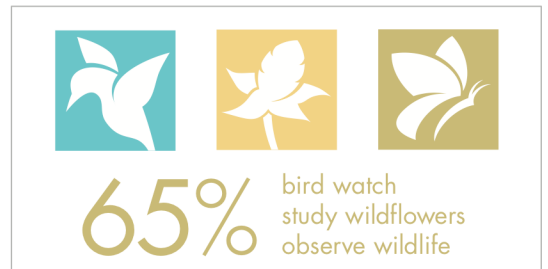


Highlights from the Three Rivers Heritage Trail 2014 User Survey and Economic Impact Report

Friends of the Riverfront is responsible for the development and maintenance of the 26-mile Three Rivers Heritage Trail. Volunteers assist Friends of the Riverfront in stewardship efforts; From March - June 2019, 343 volunteers contributed 1,020 hours of service (the equivalent of \$25,938.60) at 28 Friends of the Riverfront stewardship events along the Three Rivers Heritage Trail. 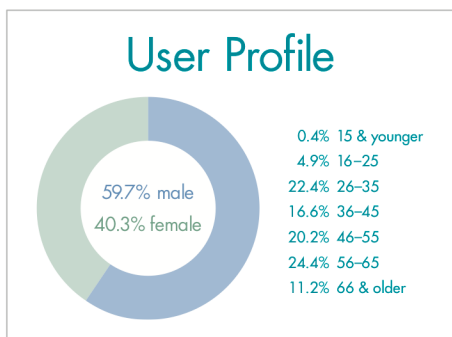
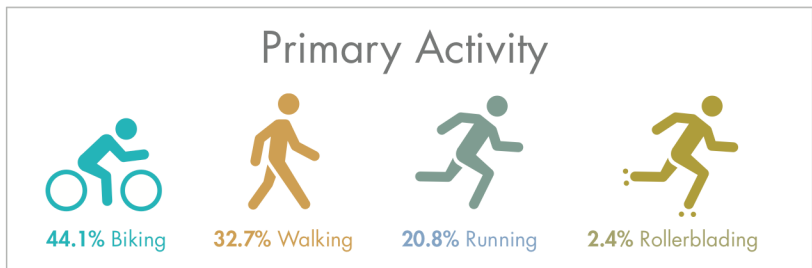
