Summary: VOPP Steering Committee Meeting to discuss Public Mtg and Design issues. The following issues were

- PennDOT to provide information on bike protected lane requirements and buffer zones from previous meeting
- > A question came up regarding the traffic turning into Get-Go (south of ARB) vs. Daily's (north of ARB). While there may be more deliveries for Daily's, there is more traffic turning into / out of the Get-Go.
- The Steering Committee participated in the following Teams Polls with the results as follows
- · Which type of bicycle lane does the committee prefer on ARB: One Bike Lane on each side (0%) vs a bidirectional lane on either the north end or south end of ARB (100%). Based on poll results, the VOPP Steering Committee unanimously selected the bi-directional bike lane on either side of the road (not both sides). Which side of ARB should the bi-directional bike lane be located: North (60%) vs South (40%). North is when
- Daily's and Plum Street are located; South is where the Get-Go is located. The One Bike Lane on each side of the ARB presents the following challenges: maintenance issues, buffer zone
- distances, type and location of protected barrier, and it impacts businesses / driveways on both sides as opposed
- For the Public Meeting, it was discussed to only show a schematic of the bi-directional bike lane on the north and south ends of ARB.: it was decided not to show the One Bike Lane on each side. We can have that in hand to le the public know it was dismissed for a variety of reasons as listed above.
- With the traffic signal warranted at ARB and Plum Street, either the north or south end would provide an ade
- Plum Street will be generally discussed as a two-phased approach: Phase I will be utilizing shared lane marking for an on-road trail and Phase II will be a protected bike lane once the engineering, permitting and property acquisition has been completed. The Plum Stream side of Plum Street appears to have less conflicts than the opposite side of the street - there will be more permitting issues on this side but overall favorable
- The Public Meeting will be held on Thursday January 19, 2023 @ 6:30PM at Steel City Rowing. Friends of the Riverfront has completed the fiver which is on their website. (https://friendsoftheriverfront.org/trail\_dev/vopptrail/)
- TranSystems will arrive early to set up and provide sign in sheets, presentation and poster boards
  - TranSystems to follow up with PennDOT to obtain some bicycle lane information o TranSystems to provide traffic info for Get-Go's and Daily's to determine turns / trips

  - TranSystems to prepare a presentation and posterboards for the public meeting send to Steering Committee
